

Safe Management Measures (SMMs) guidelines:

The following SMMs will be implemented during the Graduation Ceremony and must be strictly observed by all participants and guests.

All attendees must be:

1. **Fully vaccinated[^] under the national vaccination programme.** You will be required to present your vaccination status to TUM Asia staff upon registration at the event. A person is considered fully vaccinated two weeks after taking the second dose.
2. OR present to us the **negative results of your Pre-Event Test (PET).**

[^]An individual is considered **fully vaccinated** when he/she

- (i) has received the full regimen of Pfizer-BioNTech/Comirnaty or Moderna with an additional two weeks for the vaccine to be effective;
- (ii) has received the full regimen of vaccines in the World Health Organisation's Emergency Use Listing (WHO EUL), including their respective duration post-vaccination for the vaccines to be fully effective, and had their vaccination records ingested in MOH's national IT systems;
- (iii) recovered from COVID-19 within the last 270 days; and
- (iv) unvaccinated and has a negative result on a pre-event test by a MOH-approved COVID-19 test provider in the past 24 hours, covering the full duration of the activity.

Attendees are to adhere to the following SMMs on the day of the Ceremony (*subject to change, depending on how the COVID-19 situation develops*):

SMM	Description
TraceTogether-only SafeEntry (TTSE)	All participants will need to check in to the event venue via TTSE.
Guest registration	All guests to these events will need to be registered. No walk-ins are allowed.
Wearing of Mask	All guests will not be allowed to mask off during the event. Speakers should not mask off when giving their speech.
Photo Taking	Participants and guests can take photos in at designated locations in groups of no more than 5. When taking photos, all individuals should be 1m apart. Individuals should remain masked at all times, including for official photo taking on-stage. All guests are requested to remain seated in their assigned seats throughout the ceremony and must not leave their seats to take photographs.
