



APPLICATION PROCESS FOR MASTER PROGRAMMES

Admissions Open from 15 Oct 2017 to 31 March 2018

TUM Asia accepts only a single intake for our MSc programmes each year, with the course commencing usually in **end July/early August**. Before you apply, please ensure that you meet the **minimum admission requirements** for the programme that you are applying for

1. Submit Online Application

- Submit your online application (with softcopy application documents) through our [Online Application Portal](#)
- Make the payment of the application fee (S\$79 (inclusive of GST))

2. Pre-Assessment *(4 to 6 weeks)*

- We will check through your application and the uploaded softcopy documents. Please be patient with us while you wait for the results of the pre-assessment

3. Submit Notarised Hardcopy Documents

- If we have informed you to mail your notarised hardcopy application documents to us, you may mail them to:-

- Please refrain from asking about the status of your application before 2 weeks is up. Different applications may take different amounts of time for screening, please do not compare your application with that of another applicant.

5. Scholarship Results *(from April onwards)*

- Applicants do not need to apply for scholarships separately.
- All applicants who have been accepted into the programme(s) will be automatically considered for available TUM Asia & industry scholarships.
