



# APPLICATION PROCESS FOR MASTER PROGRAMMES

Admissions Open from 1 Oct 2019 to 31 March 2020

TUM Asia accepts only a single intake for our MSc programmes each year, with the course commencing usually in **end July/early August**. Before you apply, please ensure that you meet the **minimum admission requirements** for the programme that you are applying for.

## 1. Submit Online Application

- Submit your online application (with softcopy application documents) through our [Online Application Portal](#)
- Make the payment of the processing fee (S\$79 (inclusive of GST))

## 2. Pre-Assessment *(2 to 4 weeks)*

- We will check through your application and the uploaded softcopy documents. Please be patient with us while you wait for the results of the pre-assessment.

## 3. Submit Notarised Hardcopy Documents

- All applicants who have been accepted into the programme(s) will be automatically considered for available TUM Asia & industry scholarships.
